QuickStart Supports Login Model Blocks

- Choose an existing Model Block to use in the QuickStart generated scenario instead of picking a user.
- Model Block must have a “Sub-Type” of “Login”.
- Improves test maintenance from day 1 as you no longer need to have individually maintained login steps in QuickStart generated scenarios.

QuickStart Supports Navigation Model Blocks

- Choose an existing Model Block to use in “Catalog” and “Record Producer” QuickStart generated scenarios for navigation.
- Model Block must have a “Sub-Type” of “Navigation”.
- Improves test maintenance from day 1 as you no longer need to have individually maintained steps for portal and catalog navigation in QuickStart generated scenarios.

QuickStart Adds Fulfiller Validations to Request

- QuickStart “Catalog Item” and “Record Producer” scenarios can be generated with fulfiller validations included.
- Enables users to generate a requester scenario with an extra story to validate the corresponding fulfiller record.
- Open catalog item → Validate catalog item → Submit catalog item → Navigate to fulfiller record → Validate fulfiller record

QuickStart Supports Validation Only Scenarios

- QuickStart “Create Form Test” introduces a choice of scenario type.
- Choose to “Submit Form” (existing behaviour) or “Validate Form”.
- Selecting “Validate Form” allows users to generate form validations without generating record submission steps.
- Enables ability to generate validations for each workflow stage.

QuickStart Supports HR “Create Case” module

- ServiceNow’s Human Resources (HR) application uses a unique page for initiating the creation of new Cases.
- QuickStart now utilises AutomatePro’s OOTB actions to generate the steps required to populate these fields removing the need for additional manual test creation effort.

QuickStart Offers Greater Control of Validations

- Positive validations used to be included by default with users optionally adding negative validations.
- QuickStart now gives users full control over the type of validations generated.
- Enables greater customer visibility of QuickStarts capabilities and supports generation of “creation-only” scenarios containing no validations.

QuickStart Raises New Requirement Dev Tasks

- AutomatePro supports most field types, but customers sometimes use fields types that are less common and not yet supported.
- QuickStart “Create Forms Test” now generates new requirement steps and associated Dev Tasks for field types not supported by AutomatePro.
- Tasks clearly recommend to the customer that they create a Custom Action to deal with that field in their scenario.

Categorise Model Blocks with a Sub-Type

- Model Blocks now have a “Sub-Type” field to categorise their type:
 - Login
 - Logout
 - Navigation
 - Approval
 - Search
 - Etc.
- Improves usability of Model Blocks and enables them to be picked in QuickStart.

Multi Test Run Upgrade Readiness Report

- The Upgrade Readiness report now allows multiple Test Runs to be included in a single report.
- Enables upgrade tests to be executed in smaller chunks but still generate a single upgrade report comparing the baseline and comparison results.

New Out-of-the-Box Checks

- Portal menu option is displayed / not displayed
 - Validate the presence of a portal menu option.
- Alert text is present
 - Validate the text displayed within an alert is what you expect.

New Out-of-the-Box Actions

- Click portal tile
 - Navigate via icon link tiles commonly found on the portal homepage.
- Perform portal search
 - Search using the portal search box.
- Close portal modal
 - Close the Guided Tour introduction modal and other similar modals.
- Catalogue field entry
 - This existing action and associated checks now supports population and validation of catalogue fields in a variable editor.
